

David Brewer joined the Magisterial Service as a trainee court clerk in Salisbury in 1976 after being called to the Bar. He moved to Basingstoke as Deputy Clerk to the Justices before appointment as Justices' Clerk for Swindon in the early 1980s. Following reorganisations in 1999 he became Justices' Clerk for Wiltshire.

He has written numerous articles for legal periodicals and has been a contributor to all editions of *Family Court Practice* from 1993 to 2004. He is the General Editor of *Magistrates' Courts Criminal Practice* (which is now in its 8<sup>th</sup> Edition) and has been involved in the JCS Legal Adviser Manual since the first edition. He currently chairs the Editorial Panel.

David was elected to the Council of the Justices' Clerks' Society in May 2005, became Chairman of the Sentencing Committee in May 2006 and Vice President in April 2009. He was elected as President at the Society's Annual Conference in April 2010.
